AN ORDINANCE to amend the Trade Disputes and
Protection of Property Ordinance, 1943.

E NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Trade Disputes and Protection of Property (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Trade Disputes and Protection of Property Ordinance, 1943, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the definition "to intimidate" and the definition "injury" which appear therein.

3. Subsection (2) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

4. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—
(i) by deleting the words "postal telegraphic or telephonic services," which appear in subsection (1) thereof ;
(ii) by deleting the words "or at the post, telegraph or telephone offices," which appear in subsection (2) thereof.

5. Subsection (1) of section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.
