AN ORDINANCE for raising certain emergency funds for the period from 1st January, 1915, to 31st December, 1915.

WHEREAS it is expedient that provision should be made for raising certain emergency funds required in view of local conditions consequent on the present war for the period commencing on the 1st day of January in the year 1915 and ending on the thirty-first day of December in the year 1915: Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. In this Ordinance the word "shipper" includes in the case of a steam vessel the agent of the owner of such vessel.

There shall be raised, levied, collected and paid for the use of His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors for the purposes aforesaid upon the several kinds of produce hereinafter mentioned which shall have been raised or manufactured in the Colony and which shall be shipped for parts or places beyond the limits of the Colony on any day between the 1st day of January in the year 1915 and the
