AN ORDINANCE to amend the Debtors Ordinance,
Cap. 75.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Debtors Short title.
