### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section 1 of the Central Bank Act, 1964, that the said Act shall come into force on the day to be appointed by the Governor-General by Proclamation published in the Gazette, but that the Governor-General may appoint different dates on which different sections of the said Act shall come into force:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, hereby appoint the 12th day of December, 1964, as the date on which sections 1 to 35, paragraphs (a) to (c), subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (d), paragraphs (f), (h), (j), (k), (l), (p) and (s) of section 36, section 37, subsection (2) of section 48 and sections 49 to 62 of the said Act shall come into force.
