An Act to amend the Teachers' Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 14. No. 6.

[Assented to on 23rd December, 1964]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Teachers' Pensions Short title (Amendment) Act, 1964.

New section inserted in Ch. 14. No. 6 (Laws of Trinidad and Tobago 1951-1953 Vol. I.)

2. The following new section, numbered 2A, is hereby inserted in the Teachers' Pensions Ordinance immediately after section 2:

"Governor-General may vary Third Schedule

- 2A. (1) The Governor-General may by notice published in the Gazette vary the Third Schedule by adding thereto any other territory or authority, or by removing therefrom any territory or authority for the time being included therein.
- (2) A notice of variation referred to in subsection (1) shall be laid before both Houses of Parliament."

Second Schedule to Ch. 14. No. 6 amended

3. The Second Schedule to the Teachers' Pensions Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for regulation 2 of the Teachers' Pensions Regulations contained therein, of the following:

"2. In these Regulations—

Ch. 14. No. 6

"the Ordinance" means the Teachers' Pensions Ordinance:

"scheduled territory" means a territory or authority specified in the Third Schedule to the Ordinance."

Third Schedule amended

- 4. The Third Schedule to the Ordinance is amended by to Ch. 14. No. 6 the insertion in their appropriate alphabetical order of-
  - (a) "The Interim Commissioner for the West Indies", with effect from the 1st day of June, 1962; and
  - (b) "The West Indies" (meaning thereby the former Federation known by that name) with effect from the 2nd day of January, 1958.
