### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section 1 of the Central Bank Act, 1964, that the said Act shall come into force on the day to be appointed by the Governor-General by Proclamation published in the Gazette, but that the Governor-General may appoint different dates on which different sections of the said Act shall come into force:

And whereas on the 12th day of December, 1964, sections 1 to 35, paragraphs (a) to (c), subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (d), paragraphs (f), (h), (j), (k), (l), (p) and (s) of section 36, section 37, subsection (2) of section 48 and sections 49 to 62 of the said Act came into force:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, hereby appoint the 1st day of August, 1966, as the date on which the remaining sections of the said Act shall come into operation.
