AN ACT to provide for the validation of the Regulations
and Orders made under the Town and Country Plan-
ning Ordinance and of acts and things done thereunder.

[Assented to 19th December, 1977]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Town and Country Short title
Planning (Validation of Regulations and Orders) Act, 1977.

Interpretation**2. In this Act—**

G.N. 123 of 1969

“Regulations” means the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations, 1969;

G.N. 125 of 1969

“Orders” means the Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order, 1969, and the Town and Country Planning (Chaguaramas Development) Order, 1974;

G.N. 114 of 1975

Ord. 29-1960

“Ordinance” means the Town and Country Planning Ordinance, 1960.

Validation of Regulations and Orders and acts done thereunder

3. (1) Notwithstanding any rule of law to the contrary, including in particular sections 9(5) and 38(2) of the Ordinance, the Regulations and Orders made under the Ordinance are hereby declared to be and from the date of the making thereof, always to have been of full force and effect even though the Regulations and Orders were not laid before Parliament in accordance with those sections of the Ordinance.

(2) All acts and things done or omitted to be done by any person or authority under the Ordinance in exercise of the powers or in the performance of any functions or duties conferred or imposed by the Regulations or the Orders which would have been lawful had this Act then been in force shall be deemed to have been lawfully and validly done or omitted to be done.
