AN ORDINANCE to amend the Patents, Designs and Trade Marks Ordinance, Cap. 189.

[24th November, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Patents, Designs short title and Trade Marks (Amendment) Ordinance, 1932, and shall be construed as one with the Patents, Designs and Trade Construction. Marks Ordinance, Cap. 189, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance,
- 2. After section 16 of the Principal Ordinance, the Power of following section shall be inserted:—

16a. The Court shall have power upon the applica-privileges conferred by a tion of any person who alleges that his interests certificate of have been prejudicially affected by the issue of a certificate of registration under section 16 (2)

hereof to declare that the exclusive privileges and rights conferred by such certificate of registration have not been acquired on any of the grounds upon which the United Kingdom patent might be revoked under the law for the time being in force in the United Kingdom.

Such grounds shall be deemed to include the manufacture, use or sale of the invention in the Colony prior to the date of the patent in the United Kingdom, but not to include the manufacture, use or sale of the invention in the Colony by some person or persons after the date of the patent in the United Kingdom and prior to the date of the issue of the certificate of registration under Section 16 (2) hereof.

Amendment of s. 29r of Cap. 189.

3. Section 29r of the Principal Ordinance, which is enacted in section 2 of the Patents, Designs and Trade Marks (Amendment) Ordinance, 1929, (No. 2 of 1929) is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraph:—

Such grounds shall be deemed to include the publication of the design in the Colony prior to the date of registration of the design in the United Kingdom but not to include the publication of the design in the Colony by some person or persons after the date of the registration of the design in the United Kingdom and prior to the date of the issue of the certificate of registration under the said section 29c.
