AN ORDINANCE to amend the Patents, Designs and
Trade Marks Ordinance, Cap. 189.

[20th November, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Patents, ^{Short title.}
Designs and Trade Marks (Amendment) Ordinance, 1933,
and shall be construed as one with the Patents, Designs ^{Construction.}
and Trade Marks Ordinance, Cap. 189, hereinafter called ^{Commence-}
the Principal Ordinance, and shall come into operation ^{ment.}
on the date of publication in the *Royal Gazette*.

2. Section 29B of the Principal Ordinance (which is ^{Amendment}
set out in section 2 of the Patents, Designs and Trade ^{of section 29B}
Marks (Amendment) Ordinance, 1929, is hereby amended ^{of Cap. 189.}
by the deletion of the word "certified" in the third line.
