CONTROL OF IMPORTATION OF LIVE FISH ORDINANCE, CH. 32. No. 16

IMPORTATION OF ORNAMENTAL FISH INTO THE COLONY

UNDER the provisions of section 2 (1) of the Control of Importation of Live Fish Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 16, approval has been given by the Governor in Council for the importation into the Colony of ornamental fish for aquarium use, *except* the following species:—

- The Carp (*Cyprinus carpio*) and its gold variety (Japanese "Higo");
- The Goldfish (*Carassius auratus*) and all its varieties;
- The "Prussian Carp" (*Carassius carassius*);
- The "Pirai" (*Serrasalmo niger*) and allied species;
- The "Basses" (*Micropterus dolomieu* and *Micropterus salmoides*).

Notice No. 1032 appearing on page 415 of the 1951 *Royal Gazette* is hereby cancelled.
