AN ORDINANCE to amend the Crown Lands Ordinance, 1918.

[*18th March, 1921.*]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Crown Lands Short title and construction. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1921, and shall be read as one with the Crown Lands Ordinance, 1918, hereinafter called Ord. 32-1918. the Principal Ordinance.

2. The following section shall be inserted as section 4a of Appointment of Sub-Intendant. the Principal Ordinance:—

4a. It shall be lawful for the Governor, in the name of His Majesty the King, from time to time to appoint a fit and proper person to be Sub-Intendant of Crown Lands.

3. The following section shall be inserted as section 6a of the Principal Ordinance :—

- 6a. (1.) It shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time to appoint a fit and proper person to be Deputy Sub-Intendant of Crown Lands.
- (2.) Whenever by any law for the time being in force in this Colony anything is appointed to be done by the Sub-Intendant of Crown Lands, the same may be lawfully and for all purposes effectually done by the Deputy Sub-Intendant.

Passed in Council this fourth day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.
