AN ORDINANCE to amend the Crown Lands Ordinance.

[9th December, 1926.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Crown Lands ^{Short title.} (Amendment) Ordinance, 1926, and shall be read and ^{Construction.} construed as one with the Crown Lands Ordinance, herein- ^{Cap. 158.} after called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby ^{Repeal of} repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :— ^{s. 10 of} ^{Cap. 158.}

10. (1) Every grant of Crown lands shall be issued under the Public Seal of the Colony, and shall be registered by the Registrar-General under the provisions of the Real Property Ordinance, on being ^{Cap. 160.} tendered to him for that purpose.

(2) Every lease of Crown lands under the Public Seal of the Colony shall be registered by the Registrar-General in the same manner as a deed, on being tendered to him for that purpose.

Amendment of s. 11 of Cap. 158. **3.** Section 11 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words "the Crown Surveyor" after the word "Works" wherever it occurs in the section.

Amendment of s. 12 of Cap. 158. **4.** Section 12 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting after the words "Sub-Intendant" the words "or the Crown Surveyor."

Amendment of s. 13 of Cap. 158. **5.** Section 13 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words "the Crown Surveyor" after the words "Sub-Intendant" in the second line, and by inserting the words "or the Crown Surveyor" after the words "Sub-Intendant" in the fourth line of the section.

Amendment of s. 14 of Cap. 158. **6.** Section 14 (a) of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the word "three" for the word "two" therein.
