ORDER

MADE BY THE PRESIDENT PURSUANT TO THE POWERS VESTED IN HIM BY  
SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 20A OF THE CENTRAL TENDERS BOARD  
ORDINANCE, 1961 (NO. 22 OF 1961) AS AMENDED BY THE CENTRAL  
TENDERS BOARD (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1979 (NO. 36 OF 1979)

THE CENTRAL TENDERS BOARD (SECT INTERNATIONAL)  
(EXCLUSION) ORDER, 1982

WHEREAS subsection (2) of section 20A of the Central Tenders Board  
Ordinance, 1961 provides that the President may by Order published  
in the *Gazette* exclude from the provisions of the Ordinance any  
company which, having successfully undertaken one phase of a project,  
has expressed a desire and is able financially and otherwise to complete  
any other phase thereof:

And whereas Société Centrale pour l'Équipement du Territoire  
(SECT) International having successfully undertaken Phase I of the  
Oropouche Drainage and Irrigation Project, has expressed a desire  
and is able financially and otherwise to complete Phase II of the said  
Project:

Now, therefore, the President in the exercise of the powers  
vested in him as aforesaid do hereby order as follows—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Central Tenders  
Board (SECT International) (Exclusion) Order, 1982.

Exclusion

2. This Société Centrale pour l'Équipement du  
Territoire (SECT International) is hereby excluded  
from the provisions of the Central Tenders Board  
Ordinance, 1961.
