AN ORDINANCE to amend the Copra Products (Control) Ordinance, 1932.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Copra Products Short title. (Control) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be Construction. construed as one with the Copra Products (Control) Ordinance, 1932, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Amendment of s. 2 of Ordinance 1 of 1932. amended

(a) by deleting the words "and laundry soap as hereinafter defined" in the definition of "Copra Products";

(b) by deleting the definition of "Laundry Soap."

3. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (c) thereof.

4. Sub-section 1 of section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following proviso:—

Provided that in the case of copra used in the manufacture of copra products exported such sum shall not exceed three-pence for each one hundred pounds weight of such copra.

5. This Ordinance shall have retrospective effect, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 16th day of February, 1933.
