A VESTING ORDER

WHEREAS it is provided under section 16(1) of the Chaguaramas Development Authority Act, 1972 that where a development plan respecting the North-West Peninsula, as defined in the Schedule to the aforementioned Act, or any part thereof comes into force in accordance with the provisions of Part II of the Town and Country Planning Ordinance, 1960, the Governor-General may make a Vesting Order transferring to and vesting in the Chaguaramas Development Authority all or any part of the land to which such development plan relates, and thereupon—

- (a) all land and other property of every kind, including things in action, vested or deemed to be vested immediately before the commencement of the Order in the Crown in right of its Government of Trinidad and Tobago shall by virtue of this Act, and without further assurance be transferred to, and shall vest in, the Authority; and
- (b) all the rights, privileges and advantages and all the liabilities and obligations other than those of an international nature that immediately before the commencement of the Order, the Government was entitled or subject to, as the case may be, shall be transferred to and conferred or imposed upon, the Authority for the purposes of this Act,

and such development plan is now in force:

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR HUGH McSHINE, Acting Governor-General as aforesaid, do hereby order that all the land to which the said development plan relates and which before the commencement of this Order was vested in the Government of Trinidad and Tobago do now vest in the Chaguaramas Development Authority subject to the aforementioned limitations.
