AN ORDINANCE to amend the Copra Products (Control)
Ordinance, 1932.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Copra Products Short title.
(Control) (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1934, and shall Construction.
be construed as one with the Copra Products (Control)
Ordinance, 1932, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance
Ordinance. 1-1932.

2. The following shall be inserted as section 9A of the New S. 9A.
Principal Ordinance :—

9A. When a manufacturer has entered into a Purchases for
contract for the purchase and the future delivery future
of copra within a period not exceeding three delivery.
months from the date of such contract then
for the purposes of sections 8 and 9 hereof, the

price fixed by the Governor in accordance with sub-section (1) of section 8 hereof for the week in which the contract was entered into shall apply to such contract as if delivery of the copra so purchased had been made immediately, and section 9 hereof shall apply accordingly.
