AN ORDINANCE to vest in Assistant Wardens the powers of Wardens as Superintendent Registrars of Births and Deaths and District Registrars of Marriages.

[21st March, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Notwithstanding the provisions of the Registration Ordinance (No. 56) and the Marriage Ordinance (No. 59), all the powers and duties conferred and imposed on a Warden as Superintendent Registrar of Births and Deaths and District Registrar of Marriages under the said Ordinances may be exercised and performed by an Assistant Warden.

Passed in Council this Seventh day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nineteen.
