AN ACT to amend the Copra Products Control Ordinance,  
Ch. 32. No. 13.

[Assented to 8th January, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment  
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House  
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the  
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Copra Products Control Short title  
(Amendment) Act, 1972.

2. The Copra Products Control Ordinance is amended by inserting immediately after section 5 thereof the following:—

“Governor-  
General may  
waive duty  
on edible oil

5A. Notwithstanding section 5(a), the Governor-General may by Notice published in the *Gazette* waive, in whole or in part, the duty payable on deodorised edible oil manufactured in Trinidad and Tobago and delivered for consumption in Trinidad and Tobago.”
