AN ORDINANCE to amend the Bills of Exchange
Ordinance.

[6th November, 1926.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bills of Exchange (Amendment) Ordinance, 1926, and shall be read as one with the Bills of Exchange Ordinance, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance. Short title.

2. Section 60 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the following at the end thereof: Amendment of
s. 60 of
Cap 184.

A draft or order drawn by a banker on the head office or a branch of his bank in the Colony for a sum of money payable to order on demand shall be deemed to be a bill for the purposes of this section.
