AN ORDINANCE to amend the Bills of Exchange
Ordinance, Cap. 184.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bills of Exchange Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be construed as
one with the Bills of Exchange Ordinance, Cap. 184, Construction.

2. Sections 76 to 82 of the Principal Ordinance (which Cheques
relate to crossed cheques) shall apply to a banker's draft drawn on a
as if the draft were a cheque. bank by itself.

For the purposes of this section, the expression "banker's draft" means a draft payable on demand drawn by or on behalf of a bank upon itself, whether payable at the head office or some other office of the bank.
