AN ORDINANCE to amend the Royal Botanic Gardens Ordinance 1894.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Botanic Gardens Short Title. Ordinance 1904.

The Royal Botanic Gardens Ordinance 1894 and the (38-1894.) Royal Botanic Gardens Ordinance 1898 and this Ordi- (2-1898.) nance may together be cited as the Botanic Gardens Ordinances 1894-1904.

2. The definition of "the Gardens" in Section 2 of the Repeal. Royal Botanic Gardens Ordinance 1894, is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:

"The Gardens" means the Royal Botanic Gardens Definition of as delineated and set forth coloured pink and comprised "Gardens." within the line marked with the letters A to W in a certain

plan dated the 8th day of July 1903, signed by Charles Style Cochrane Esquire, Engineer in Charge of Surveys, and deposited in the office of the Sub-Intendant of Crown Lands.

Application.

3. The provisions of the Royal Botanic Gardens Ordinance 1894 and of the Royal Botanic Gardens Ordinance 1898, shall be deemed to apply to the Gardens as defined by the last preceding Section hereof.

Passed in Council this Eighteenth day of January, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four.
