AN ORDINANCE to amend the Botanic Gardens Ordinances.

[29th April, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Botanic Gardens Ordinance, 1920.

Amendment of definition of "The Gardens."

Ord. 12-1908.

2. The definition of "The Gardens" in section two of the Botanic Gardens Ordinance, 1908, is hereby amended by inserting therein after the words "Crown Lands" the words "save and except the area shown on the said plan comprised within a thick black chain-dotted line."

"Building" is substituted for "House." The definitions of "Governor in Council," "Justice" and "Summary conviction" have been omitted as unnecessary. "Warden" is defined to include Assistant Warden. A definition of "Constable" has been added.
