AN ORDINANCE to amend the Botanic Gardens  
Ordinance, Cap. 140.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Botanic Gardens Short title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be construed as Construction  
one with the Botanic Gardens Ordinance hereinafter Cap. 140.  
referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Amendment  
as follows :— of s. 2 of

(a) The definition of "The Gardens" is hereby Principal  
repealed and the following definition is sub- Ordinance.  
stituted therefor :—

"The Gardens" means the Royal Botanic Gardens  
as delineated and set forth in a certain  
plan dated the fifth day of December, 1933,  
signed by John Walker Macgillivray,  
Surveyor-General and Sub-Intendant of

Crown Lands and deposited in the office of the Sub-Intendant of Crown Lands, the boundaries whereof are thereon edged red ; save and except the following areas :—

- (i) an area the boundaries whereof are shown on the said plan, edged purple.
- (ii) three areas the boundaries whereof are shown on the said plan, edged green.
- (iii) a portion of the road known as the Lady Chancellor Road shown on the said plan as lying between the points marked "A.A" ;

and includes lands, in addition to those hereinbefore described, which may from time to time be acquired or appropriated with the sanction of the Governor and Legislative Council for any experimental plantation or for the cultivation of any vegetable products under the direction of the Curator.

- (b) The term and definition of " Superintendent " is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefor :—

" Curator " means the Curator for the time being of the gardens and includes the Economic Botanist and any Assistant Curator.

Substitution of title "Curator" for "Superintendent".

**3.** Wheresoever in the Principal Ordinance the word " Superintendent " occurs there shall be substituted therefor the word " Curator ".

Amendment of s. 4 of Principal Ordinance.

**4.** Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) In sub-section (1) thereof by the addition of the following paragraph :—

(f) for the management control and upkeep of any museum or aviary that may, with the permission of the Governor in Executive Council, be erected within the gardens

- (b) Sub-section (3) thereof is hereby repealed and sub-section (4) is renumbered as sub-section (3).

5. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

Repeal and re-enactment of s. 10 of Principal Ordinance.

“ All existing estates, interests, trusts, rights of way or other rights in, over, upon or through the gardens are hereby determined, save that a right of way on foot from the La Fantaisie Road and the Circular Road between the points marked B.B. on the said plan is hereby dedicated to the public.”

Rights of way.
