**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title.

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Bruce Stephens Trust  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be read as one with

Ch. 13. No. 3.

the Bruce Stephens Trust Ordinance.

2. No contribution, bonus or interest thereon paid by, or credited to the account of, a contributor to any Provident Fund established and maintained by the Trustees for the benefit of the Staff of the Trust shall be assignable or transferable or liable to be attached, sequestered or levied upon for or in respect of any claim whatsoever except a debt due to the Trust.

Provident Fund contributions, &c. not assignable, &c.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the rules for the governance of any Provident Fund established and maintained by the Trustees for the benefit of the staff of the Trust, the persons named in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance being at the commencement of this Ordinance members of the staff of the Trust holding the offices indicated in the second column of the said Schedule shall not be eligible to be contributors to such Provident Fund but shall, on their retirement from the service of the Trust, be paid from the funds of the Trust such pensions as they would have been respectively entitled to if they had been public officers within the meaning of the Pensions Ordinances.

Certain employees of Trust ineligible for Provident Fund benefits but entitled to pension.
