 AN ORDINANCE to amend the Country Markets
 Ordinance.

[12th December, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Country Markets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1928, and shall be read as one with the Country Markets Ordinance, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the following after paragraph (h):—

(h1) for regulating the sale of meat, fish, turtle and other marketable commodities.

(h2) for prescribing the areas in the vicinity of any market within which it shall not be lawful to sell or offer for sale any meat, fish, turtle or other marketable commodity.

Passed in Council this seventh day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight.
