AN ORDINANCE to amend the Country Markets
Ordinance, Cap. 255.

[4th April, 1940.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Country Markets Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1940, and shall be read as one
with the Country Markets Ordinance, hereinafter referred Cap. 255.
to as the Principal Ordinance.

“Marketable
commodity”
defined

2. In the Principal Ordinance, as amended by the Country Markets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1928, the term “marketable commodity” shall include livestock, ground provisions, vegetables, fruit and such other goods and articles as may be notified in the *Royal Gazette* by order of the Governor in Council.
