AN ORDINANCE to amend the Country Markets
Ordinance, Ch. 40. No. 4.

[14th September, 1944.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Country Markets Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1944, and shall be read as one
with the Country Markets Ordinance.

Ch. 40. No. 4.

Section 4
of Principal
Ordinance
amended.

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by:—

- (a) deleting the words "meat, fish, turtle and other" occurring in paragraph (i) of subsection (1);
- (b) deleting the words "meat, fish, turtle or other" occurring in paragraph (j) of subsection (1);
- (c) by substituting the following for subsection (4);

"(4) In this section "marketable commodity" means meat, fish, turtle, game, livestock, eggs, ground provisions, vegetables, fruit and such goods and articles as may be notified in the *Royal Gazette* by order of the Governor in Council".

Passed in Council this twenty-fifth day of August, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-four.
