TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
Act No. 15 of 1971

AN ACT to amend the Central Marketing Agency Act, 1966.

[Assented to 28th April, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Central Marketing ^{Short title} Agency (Amendment) Act, 1971.

2. The Central Marketing Agency Act is amended—

(a) in section 2—

(i) by substituting for the definition of “agricultural produce” the following:

“ “agricultural produce” means ground provisions, live-stock, eggs and any farm produce or any foodstuffs cultivated above or beneath the soil;”;

(ii) by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical order the following—

“ “livestock” means any animals that are commonly reared for the purpose of food for human consumption and includes cattle, sheep, goats, pigs or poultry;

“poultry” includes any fowl, chicken, turkey, duck, goose or other bird commonly reared for the purpose of food for human consumption.”;

(b) in section 10, by substituting for subsection (3) the following—

“(3) Without limiting the generality of the provisions of subsection (2) the Agency may—

(a) export, import and sell for export any agricultural produce;

(b) act as sole importer of any type of agricultural produce for which a guaranteed price is offered;

- (c) export and issue licences for the exportation of any type of agricultural produce or any handicraft product approved by the Minister;
- (d) implement such price support measures as may from time to time be approved by the Governor-General;
- (e) sell by auction or otherwise or arrange for the sale by auction or otherwise of any agricultural produce reared or cultivated by farmers or organisations of farmers in Trinidad and Tobago;
- (f) subject to the approval of the Minister requisition in any retail market such space as may be required for the purpose of carrying out its activities.”.
