### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 2 of the Country Markets Ordinance, Ch. 40. No. 4, it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council from time to time, by proclamation, to declare any premises, not being within the limits of any borough, to be a public market:

And whereas it is expedient that the premises hereinafter described, not being within the limits of a borough, should be declared to be a public market:

Now, therefore, I, EDWARD BETHAM BEETHAM, Governor as aforesaid, do hereby in Executive Council declare the premises described in the Schedule hereto to be a public market within the meaning of the above-mentioned Ordinance.

#### SCHEDULE

The premises situate at Roxborough in the Parish of St. Paul in the Island-Ward of Tobago and bounded as follows:—

NORTH—Windward Main Road.

SOUTH—Lands of Roxborough Estate.

EAST —Lands of Roxborough Estate.

WEST —Crown lands and lands of Roxborough Estate.
