A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 2 of the Country Markets Ordinance, Ch. 40. No. 4, it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council from time to time, by proclamation, to declare any premises, not being within the limits of any Borough, to be a public market:

And whereas it is expedient that the premises hereinafter described, not being within the limits of a Borough, should be declared to be a public market;

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Acting Governor as aforesaid, in Executive Council do hereby declare the premises described in the Schedule hereto to be a public market within the meaning of the said Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

The premises situate in Penal, in the Ward of Siparia, in the County of St. Patrick, and bounded as follows:—

North—By the San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road;

South—Crown Lands and Private Road;

East —Ramlall Street;

West —Private Road.

(The Children Ordinance, Ch. 4. No. 21)
