## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 2 of the Country Markets Ordinance, Ch. 40. No. 4, it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General from time to time, by proclamation, to declare any premises, not being within the limits of any borough, to be a public market:

And Whereas it is expedient that the premises hereinafter described, not being within the limits of a borough, should be declared to be a public market:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, do hereby declare the premises described in the Schedule to be a public market for the purposes of the said Ordinance.

### SCHEDULE

The premises situate at Fyzabad in the Ward of Siparia, in the County of St. Patrick, and bounded as follows:—

On the NORTH—By the Gower Well Road,

On the SOUTH—By lands of Noorsingh, now or formerly Frank Vivian Eckel,

On the EAST —By lands originally granted to Isaree,

On the WEST —By lands of Noorsingh, now or formerly Frank Vivian Eckel,

which premises are more particularly shown and delineated and coloured raw sienna on a survey plan filed E.C. 103 in the vault of the Lands and Surveys Department, Red House.
