ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Short title. Cinematograph
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1948 and shall be construed as one
with the Cinematograph Ordinance hereinafter referred to as Ch. 30. No. 10.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting in paragraphs (a) and (b) of the definition of "British film" the words and figures "the Cinematograph Films Acts, 1927 and 1938" and by substituting in each case the words and figures "the Cinematograph Films Acts, 1938 and 1948".
