A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 2 of the Country Markets Ordinance, Ch. 40. No. 4, it is provided *inter alia* that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General from time to time, by proclamation, to declare any premises, not being within the limits of any borough, to be a public market:

And whereas it is expedient that the premises described in the Schedule hereto, not being within the limits of a borough, should be declared to be a public market:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, hereby declare the premises described in the Schedule hereto to be a public market.

SCHEDULE

The premises situate at Mayaro in the Ward of Guayaguayare in the County of Mayaro and bounded as follows:—

North—Naparima-Mayaro Road,

South—A drain,

East —Mayaro-Guayaguayare Road,

West —Lands now or formerly of Ching Hong, and which premises are more particularly shown and delineated and coloured raw sienna on a survey plan filed at folio 122 of Book 937 in the vault of the Lands and Surveys Department, Red House.
