AN ACT to provide for the coming into operation of the
Cipriani Labour College Act, 1971 and for the
validation of acts or things done thereunder.

[Assented to 18th December, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Cipriani Labour ^{Short title}
College (Commencement and Validation) Act, 1975.

Commencement

2. Notwithstanding any rule of law to the contrary, including in particular subsection (2) of section 1 of the Cipriani Labour College Act, 1971 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") the Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 14th day of February, 1972.

Validation of Acts

3. All acts or things done by the College or by any person, Board or Committee acting on its behalf in the purported exercise of any of its functions, duties and powers under the Act between the 14th day of February, 1972 and the date of the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been lawfully and validly done.
