AN ACT to amend the Cipriani Labour College Act,
Chap. 39:51

[Assented to 11th August, 1988]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Cipriani Labour Short title
College (Amendment) Act, 1988.

Section 2 of
Chap. 39:51
amended

2. Section 2 of the Cipriani Labour College Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") is amended by inserting in its appropriate alphabetical order the following definition:

" "Minister" means the Minister to whom responsibility for the administration of Labour is assigned."

Section 4
of the Act
amended

3. Section 4 of the Act is amended—

(a) by repealing and replacing subsection (1) thereof as follows—

4. (1) The affairs of the College shall be managed by a Board of Governors consisting of nine members appointed by the Minister as follows:

- (a) two members nominated by the Trinidad and Tobago Labour Congress;
- (b) two members nominated by the Council of Progressive Trade Unions;
- (c) the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry with responsibility for Labour, or his representative;
- (d) an educator nominated by the Minister with responsibility for Education;
- (e) the Commissioner for Co-operative Development, or his representative; and
- (f) two members from the general public."; and

(b) by substituting for subsection (2) the following—

(2) Members appointed to the Board under subsections 1(a), (b) and (f) shall subject to subsections (5) and (6) hold office for a period not exceeding three years.
