AN ORDINANCE to amend the Criminal Offences Ordinance, Ch. 4. No. 4.

[29th March, 1945.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Offences (Amendment) Ordinance, 1945. Short title.

Amendment
of section 7 of
Ch. 4. No. 4.

2. Section 7 of the Criminal Offences Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words and semicolon "effecting a public mischief;" after the comma in the second line thereof and of the words and full-stop "Effecting a public mischief." in the marginal note thereof above the words "Cheat or fraud."
