A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Act, 1976 that the Governor-General shall by Proclamation published in the *Gazette* fix a day after the dissolution of the last Parliament under the former Constitution for the coming into operation of the Constitution:

And whereas under and by virtue of subsection (2) of section 50 of the former Constitution the last Parliament stood dissolved as from the 19th day of June, 1976:

Now, therefore, I, ELLIS EMMANUEL INNOCENT CLARKE, Governor-General as aforesaid, do hereby fix the 1st day of August, 1976, for the coming into operation of the Constitution.
