Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1990.

2. The Emergency Powers Regulations, 1990 are amended—

(a) in regulation 2 by substituting for the words “section 10(3)” occurring in the definition of “period of public emergency”, the words “section 10”;

(b) in regulation 3(1) by deleting the words “and the Emergency Powers Act” occurring in line two;

(c) in regulation 8(2) by substituting for the words “protected place” occurring in line two, the words “a protected place”;

(d) in regulation 14 by adding immediately after subregulation (3) the following new subregulation:

“ (4) Subregulations (2) and (3) do not apply where the instruments referred to therein are used for the purpose of political campaigning in preparation for the 1990 bye-election for a parliamentary representative for the Diego Martin Central constituency.”;

(e) in regulation 21 by substituting for the word “office” occurring in line three, the word “officer”;

(f) in the First Schedule by adding immediately after paragraph 5 the following new paragraph:

“ 6. Political meetings held for the purpose of campaigning for the 1990 bye-election of a parliamentary representative for the Diego Martin Central constituency.”; and

(g) in the Second Schedule by substituting for the word “practice” occurring in line three of the definition of “legal adviser” or “legal representative”, the word “practise”.

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 20th day of November, 1990.
