ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER REGULATION 4 OF THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF.

THE CURFEW (NO. 2) ORDER, 1990

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfew (No. 2) Order, 1990.

Citation

2. The Curfew Order, 1990 is amended by substituting for the Second and Third Schedules, the following new Schedules—

“SECOND SCHEDULE

The Curfew shall be in force between 3.00 p.m. and 1.00 p.m. on the day following in Port-of-Spain, in the area bounded—

- (a) on the North partly by St. Clair Avenue and partly by Queen’s Park West;
- (b) on the West by Gray Street;
- (c) on the South partly by Rust Street and partly by Warner Street; and
- (d) on the East by Picton Street.

THIRD SCHEDULE

In the remainder of Trinidad and Tobago the Curfew is in force between the hours of 6.00 p.m. and noon on the day following.”.
