AN ORDINANCE to amend the Criminal Procedure
Ordinance, Ch. 4. No. 3.

Commencement

[6th May, 1954.]

Enactment

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Procedure
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with
the Criminal Procedure Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as
the Principal Ordinance.

Ch. 4. No. 3

2. The following section is hereby added to the Principal Ordinance immediately after section 4:—

“Chief Justice
may direct
holding of
more than
one Court at
San Fernando
Criminal
Sessions

4A. For the purposes of any Criminal Sessions of the Court for the trial of criminal cases at San Fernando, the Chief Justice may direct that more than one court shall be held, and if he so directs such number of Judges as the Chief Justice shall determine shall hold separate courts at such Criminal Sessions.”
