AN ACT to amend the Criminal Procedure Act,
(Chap. 12:02).

[Assented to 8th April, 1982]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Criminal Procedure **Short title**
(Amendment) Act, 1982.

Amendment of
section 3 of Act
(Chap. 12:02)

2. Section 3(5) of the Criminal Procedure Act is amended by—

- (1) deleting the words “Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2)” and substituting therefor the words “Notwithstanding subsections (1), (2) and (3)”;
- (2) adding the following after paragraph (d)—
 - “(e) enter for trial at Tobago any criminal case which but for this section would be triable in Port-of-Spain or San Fernando;
 - (f) enter for trial at Port-of-Spain any criminal case which but for this section would be triable in Tobago;
 - (g) transfer the trial of any case entered for trial at Port-of-Spain, or San Fernando to Tobago;
 - (h) transfer the trial of any case entered for trial at Tobago to Port-of-Spain or San Fernando.”.
