A PROCLAMATION

Now, therefore, I, NOOR MOHAMED HASSANALI, President, as aforesaid, do hereby appoint the Red House, Port-of-Spain, as the place at which the Second Session of the Fifth Parliament of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago shall be held and 1.30 p.m. on Thursday the 21st day of November, 1996, as the time at which the said Session shall commence.
