### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section 67 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago *inter alia*, that there shall be a session of each House of Parliament once at least in every year:

And whereas the Fifth Session of the Fifth Parliament commenced on the 8th day of October, 1999:

And whereas it is therefore deemed expedient that Parliament be prorogued:

And whereas it is provided by subsection (1) of section 68 of the Constitution that the President, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, may at any time prorogue or dissolve Parliament:

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR N. R. ROBINSON, President as aforesaid, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 68 of the said Constitution, do hereby declare that Parliament shall stand prorogued on Saturday the 7th day of October, 2000.
