THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO, CHAP. 1:01

ORDER

MADE BY THE POLICE SERVICE COMMISSION WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
PRIME MINISTER PURSUANT TO SECTION 127 OF THE CONSTITUTIONTHE POLICE SERVICE COMMISSION (DELEGATION OF POWERS)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1990

- Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Police Service Commission (Delegation of Powers) (Amendment) Order, 1990.
- Schedule amended 2. Clause 3 of the Police Service Commission (Delegation of Powers) Order is amended by substituting the words "First and Second Schedules" for the word "Schedule" wherever it occurs.
- Schedule amended 3. The Schedule to the Police Service Commission (Delegation of Powers) Order is amended as follows:
- (a) by substituting for the word "SCHEDULE" the words "FIRST SCHEDULE";
 - (b) in Part 2, by repealing subparagraph (g) in paragraph 1;
 - (c) by revoking Part 3;
 - (d) by revoking Part 4;
 - (e) in Part 5, by revoking subparagraphs (a)(ii), (b) and (c) in paragraph 1, and paragraphs 2 and 3.
- New Schedule 4. The Police Service Commission (Delegation of Powers) Order is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new Schedule—

"SECOND SCHEDULE

DISCIPLINARY POWERS DELEGATED

For the purposes of regulation 81 of the Police Service Commission Regulations an offence which a Head of Division referred to in that regulation has jurisdiction to hear and determine pursuant to being appointed as a disciplinary tribunal under regulation 82 of those Regulations is an act amounting to a breach of a regulation in Part XI of the Police Service Regulations as specified in Column 1 of the following Table and described in Column 2 of that Table.
