OF POWERS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1996

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Police Service Commission (Delegation of Powers) (Amendment) Order, 1996.

First
Schedule
amended

2. The First Schedule to the Police Service Commission (Delegation of Powers) Order is amended by deleting from Part 2, paragraphs 1(a)(i) and (ii) and substituting the following:

“(i) The power to appoint police officers to offices in the Second Division of the Police Service and to confirm the appointment of police officers to such offices in accordance with the Regulations, but the power hereby delegated shall not, subject to the following provisions of this subparagraph, include power to terminate an appointment on probation or extend a period of probation under regulation 40.

(ii) In the case of a person recruited for training to serve as a police officer in the Second Division of the Police Service, the power to terminate the appointment at any time on the ground of unsuitability arising from any cause.”
