THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 2006

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Citation
Commission (Amendment) Regulations, 2006.

2. The Public Service Commission Regulations are amended in Regulation
regulation 101 by deleting subregulation (2) and substituting the 101 amended
following new subregulation: Chap. 1:01

“ (2) In the hearing of any matter before it the Tribunal
may act without regard to technicalities and legal form and
shall not be bound to follow the rules of evidence stipulated
in the Evidence Act, but the Tribunal may inform itself on Chap. 7:02
any matter in such manner as it thinks just and may take
into account opinion evidence and such facts as it considers
relevant but in any such case, the parties to the proceedings
shall be given the opportunity if they so desire, of adducing
evidence in regard thereto.”
