THE POLICE SERVICE COMMISSION (AMENDMENT) (NO. 3)
REGULATIONS, 2006

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police Service Citation
Commission (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2006.

2. Regulation 84 of the Police Service Commission Regulations is Regulation 84
amended by— amended
Chap. 1:01

(a) by deleting subregulations (1) and (2) and substituting the
following:

Warning and Investigation “ 84. (1) Where the Commissioner
receives a report or an allegation is received
from which it appears that a police officer
may have committed an offence to which
regulation 77 applies, the Commissioner
shall in addition to making a report as
required by regulation 77 concurrently warn
the police officer in writing of the allegation.

(2) An Investigating Officer from
the Public Service Investigations Unit shall
be appointed by the Director of Personnel
Administration to investigate the
allegation.”;

(b) inserting after subregulation (2), the following:

“ (2A) An Investigating Officer may also be
appointed from within the Police Service on the
instruction of the Commission and shall hold an office in
a grade higher than that of the officer against whom the
allegation has been made.”.
