AN ORDINANCE to amend the Companies
Ordinance, 1913.

[1st January, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Companies Ordinance, 1922, and shall be read as one with the Companies Ordinance, 1913, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance. Short title.
