AN ORDINANCE to amend the Commissions of Enquiry Ordinance, Cap. 282.

[*24th November, 1932.*]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Commissions of Enquiry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1932, and shall be construed as one with the Commissions of Enquiry Ordinance, Cap. 282, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title.
Construction.

2. The following section shall be inserted in the Principal Ordinance as section 9A:

9A. Any person whose conduct is the subject of enquiry under this Ordinance, or who is in any way implicated or concerned in the matter under enquiry, Appearance of
Counsel.

shall be entitled to be represented by counsel at the whole of the enquiry, and any other person who may consider it desirable that he should be so represented may, by leave of the Commissioners, be represented in the manner aforesaid.
