### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the 1st day of October, 1952, the Governor, under the provisions of section 5 (1) of the County Councils Ordinance, 1952, appointed the year 1952 as a year for the compilation of lists of electors in each electoral division of all persons entitled under the provisions of the said Ordinance to vote at the election of members of the County Council of the electoral district of which such division forms part :

And whereas lists of electors have, under the authority of the said Proclamation, been duly compiled in respect of the several divisions comprised within each electoral district :

And whereas by section 5 (2) of the said Ordinance it is provided that the Governor may by proclamation appoint a date on which such lists shall come into force :

Now, therefore, I, HUBERT ELVIN RANCE, Governor as aforesaid, do order and proclaim that the aforementioned lists of electors shall come into force as from the date of this Proclamation.
